## Women Educating Women Scholarship Application

Applicants may be a high school junior or senior, high school graduate, GED recipient, or enrolled in a postsecondary program. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 thus far in their educational pursuits. The scholarship must be used for postsecondary education expenses during the 2017-2018 academic year.

- 1) **Academic transcript** or proof of receiving a GED
- 2) **Resumè.** Include all work history, community involvement, and extra-curricular activities.
- 3) **Typed essay** of 400 words or less that highlights a woman who has inspired you to succeed and to achieve your postsecondary education. Essays will be judged on writing skills, originality and the clarity of the answer.
