NOTICE

This citation is issued pursuant to KRS 65.8801 et. seq. and Chapter 33.180 of the City of Hopkinsville Code of Ordinances. The violation with which you have been charged is a civil offense.

If you choose not to contest the citation and pay the penalty to the City within seven (7) days, the fine for this offense is a minimum of \$200 or \$10 per acre, whichever is greater, not to exceed \$300. Failure to pay within seven (7) days will result in the addition of a \$50.00 administrative fee. All acreage calculations shall be based on PVA records.

If you choose to contest the citation and request a hearing before the Code of Ordinance Enforcement Board, the maximum penalty that may be imposed for this violation is \$400.00. In addition to the fine imposed by the Board, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be assessed.

Failure to pay the applicable civil penalty or request a hearing, in writing, from the Code of Ordinance Enforcement Board within seven (7) days of the issuance of this citation shall constitute a waiver of your right to contest the citation and the determination that a violation was committed shall be final and nonappealable.

In this event, the City will charge the property owner to cover the City's expenses. This is above and beyond possible fines imposed by the Code of Ordinance Enforcement Board.

OPTION #1:

You may decide not to contest the citation and pay the civil penalty indicated in the NOTICE portion of the citation form by mail, or in person, within seven (7) days from the date of issuance.

A. If paying by mail, you must send a cashier's check, money order, or personal check. Please do not send a cash payment! Checks must be made payable to: City of Hopkinsville. You may mail the amount of the fine indicated on the citation, along with a copy of your citation to:

OPTION #2:

If you disagree with the citation and wish to have a hearing, you may request a hearing before the City of Hopkinsville Code of Ordinance Enforcement Board. Your request for a hearing must be in writing and the request must be received by the City Clerk within seven (7) days of the date the citation was issued. You may use the attached form to request a hearing before the Board. The written request for a hearing must be mailed to the following address:

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND FINAL ORDER

The Respondent, VAUGHT & SEAVER PROPERTIES, LLC, being properly notified of the violation(s) on property located at, 550 MOORES DR, HOPKINSVILLE, KY 42240, and failing to exercise his/her rights as contained in section KRS 65.8825(6), Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Order are issued as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Respondent, VAUGHT & SEAVER PROPERTIES, LLC is the owner or person in charge of property located at 550 MOORES DR, HOPKINSVILLE, KY 42240.

The Respondent was issued a citation by MIKE GUESS, Code Enforcement Officer, dated June 1, 2017 which charged the Respondent with a violation of Chapter 93.03 of the City of Hopkinsville, Kentucky Code of Ordinances, described as follows: Overgrown.

The Respondent failed to respond to said citation within seven (7) days as required by KRS 65.8825(6) and the Hopkinsville Code of Ordinances, Chapter 133.188(F).

It is found that the condition described in the citation did, in fact, exist at the time the citation was issued, and that the condition was caused by the Respondent, or was the responsibility of the Respondent, as owner or person in charge of the property on which the violation occurred.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

It is concluded, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact, that Respondent, VAUGHT & SEAVER PROPERTIES, LLC has committed a violation of Chapter 93.03 of the City of Hopkinsville, Kentucky Code of Ordinances, as charged in the citation.

FINAL ORDER


Respondent, VAUGHT & SEAVER PROPERTIES, LLC, is ordered to pay \$250.00, which includes the \$200.00 civil fine set forth in the citation and a \$50.00 administrative fee. Payment shall be made to City of Hopkinsville, c/o Tax Office, 715 South Virginia Street, P.O. Box 707, Hopkinsville, KY 42240.

In the event this violation has not been remedied, the City of Hopkinsville may take action to remedy the violation. If the City remedies the violation, the property owner will be charged for all expenses incurred in addition to the civil fine set forth in this Order.


