Meet managers of various City offices and learn what services they provide on behalf of the City.

### PUBLIC WORKS

Tour various public works facilities and learn about the services they provide, including streets, grounds maintenance, and parks and recreation.

### EXECUTIVE/LEGISLATIVE

Discover the history of Hopkinsville, learn the differences between the executive and legislative branches of local government, and meet local elected officials.

### POLICE DEPARTMENT

Tour the Public Safety Complex which includes Police and ECC offices. Learn about the organizational structure and internal services offered by HPD.

### FIRE DEPARTMENT

Tour the Main Fire Station and hear about the challenges our firefighters, EMTs, and paramedics face.
