All work to be undertaken as part of this project must be undertaken in accordance with all local, state, and federal regulations and requirements. This project will utilize local, state, and federal funds. A 5% Bid Bond is required for this project.

The City of Hopkinsville hereby notifies all firms that it will affirmatively assure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this request for bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin on consideration for an award. Successful contractor shall comply with all federal, state, and local DBE requirements applicable to this project. All DBEs shall be pre-qualified with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet. The DBE goal for this project is 5%.
