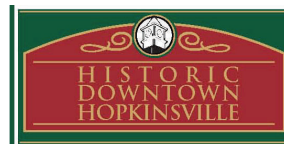

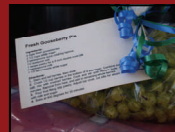


We are located in the heart of Historic Downtown Hopkinsville in Founders Square at the corner of 9th & Main Streets. FREE PARKING is available in Founders Square, along Little River Park, and along Main Street.

## Downtown Farmers Market Products

Our vendors offer a wide variety of fresh fruits and vegetables, cut flowers, bedding plants (perennials and annuals), herbs, canned goods, baked goods, honey, soaps, lotions, handmade natural beeswax candles, jams, jellies, and wine.

**Fresh fruits** (in season): strawberries, black raspberries, red raspberries, blackberries, gooseberries, watermelons, cantaloupes, melons, apples, peaches, nectarines, pears, grapes, and rhubarb.



**Fresh veggies** (in season): collard greens, turnip greens, lettuce, summer squash, butternut squash, cucumbers, tomatoes, onions, new potatoes, sweet potatoes, sweet corn, eggplant, zucchini, green beans, butter beans, turnips, bell peppers, sweet peppers, habanero peppers, arugula, asparagus, beets, cabbage, garlic, green onions, kale, kohlrabi, okra, peas, radishes, and pumpkins.



**Bedding plants, annuals, perennials, cut flowers, and herbs** include the following: butterfly weed, gooseberries, poppies, ferns, cone flowers, mandevilla, bouganvilla, hibiscus, petunias, pansies, mums, basil, cilantro, lavender, thyme, peppermint, moss, roses, dahlias, zinnias,



and a wide variety of hanging baskets.

**Canned goods** include the following: okra, dill pickles, bread & butter pickles, squash, tomato juice, salsa, relish, and a wide variety of jams and jellies.



**Baked goods and honey-related products** include the following: honey spice cake, surprise brownies, applesauce cake, raw honey, comb honey, honey walnuts, honey pecans, honey-filled candy, soaps, lotions, handmade natural beeswax candles, and lip balm.

**Wine varieties** include the following: Fruit Hill White, Bluegrass White, Pennyroyal, Lady Genevieve, Red Bridge, Foch, & Duke's Ridge.



**Specialty & Seasonal Products** include the following: gourds, hay, straw, corn stalks, & Indian corn.
