

**CITY OF HOPKINSVILLE - INVITATION TO BID
HFD STATION 2 INTERIOR RENOVATIONS PROJECT**

The City of Hopkinsville will receive Sealed Bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, and services for the Hopkinsville Fire Department Station 2 Interior Renovations Project until **2:00 PM local time on Tuesday, December 14, 2021**. Bids will be opened and read aloud at 2:00 PM at the Hopkinsville Municipal Center, 715 South Virginia Street, Conference Room 214, Second Floor, Hopkinsville, KY 42240. Each bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and clearly marked **“SEALED BID – HFD Station 2 Interior Renovations Project, Bid Number 2021-10220-001.”**

Bidders may have one representative attend the Bid Opening and must follow any and all Covid precautions the City of Hopkinsville has adopted at that time in their facilities. Only the questions answered in writing in addenda will be considered a part of the bid documents. All questions shall be submitted no later than **2:00 PM local time on December 7, 2021**. A **MANDATORY Pre-Bid Meeting** is scheduled for **Tuesday, November 30, 2021 at 10:00 AM local time** at the Hopkinsville Fire Department Station 2, 1108 Skyline Drive, Hopkinsville, KY 42240.

Partial sets or individual drawings will not be issued. Bidders may not obtain individual specification sections. Bids shall be Stipulated Lump sum bids. Bid documents may be examined at the following locations:

Bidding Documents, including Drawings and Specifications, may be obtained from Spurr Architecture (address above) for a non-refundable fee of \$75.00. Checks made payable to Spurr Architecture, PLLC.

A certified check, made payable to the City of Hopkinsville, or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the bidder and acceptable sureties in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid shall be submitted with each bid. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish an acceptable performance and payment bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract sum.

City of Hopkinsville reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities and enter into a contract with the best qualified bidder. Bids received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids will be returned to the bidder unopened. Any bid that is not submitted in the proper form will not be considered. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days subsequent to opening of bids.
